

# Marymount Primary School

## Primary 1 Special Admission

1. As by tradition and approved by the Education Bureau (EDB), there will be **4 classes in Primary 1**, and with **30 - 33 students in each** since September 2009.
2. As our school is an aided school, **most seats in Primary 1 are filled** by allocation through the *Discretionary Stage* as well as the *Central Allocation Stage* of the Primary One Admission (POA) System according to guidelines and procedures of the Education Bureau (EDB).
3. Those who have submitted application and/or portfolios earlier to the School **NEED NOT re-submit** as records are still kept at our General Office.
4. To fill vacancies, short-listed applicants and their parents will be invited to come to the School by telephone for **Special Admission Interviews**.
5. Please find **School-based Criteria** for **Primary 1 Special Admission** below for reference:
  - Personal merits: abilities, talents and potential
  - Demonstrated family support
  - Putting down '**Marymount Primary School**' as '**First Choice**' in *Discretionary Stage* and/or *Central Allocation Stage* for POA by the EDB
  - Cultural affiliation
6. The List of Successful applicants and the Waiting List will be posted up on School website. Successful applicants will be notified by telephone.
7. If no vacancies are available, all records of applicants' performances will be destroyed in September. Applications will have to be filed in again for those who are interested to fill seats for another school year.
