**Primary One Admission (POA) 2025 - 2026**  
**Discretionary Places Admission Stage 小一自行分配學位**

Marymount Primary School is an aided Primary School. In line with the procedures for processing discretionary places suggested by the Education Bureau (EDB) and currently adopted by schools in Net No. 12, Hong Kong Island, the following outlines our way of handling applicants for Primary One Admission (POA) in September 2024, Discretionary Places Admission Stage:

**1. Submission of Application Forms**

Parents who intend to apply for a discretionary place in our school may submit applications through one of the following methods:

**Method A – Submission via ePOA**

Parents may submit the applications via POA e-platform (ePOA) from **19 to 27 September 2024** (till 11:59 p.m.). Parents are required to upload the copies of the supporting documents to the ePOA.

**Method B – Paper Form Submission**

Parents may submit the completed Application Form (Hard Copy) with photocopies of the supporting documents to our school in person from **23 to 27 September 2024**.

**2. Handling of Applicants with Equal Scores**

Education Bureau (EDB) will draw lots for us. Results will be released on **18 November 2024 (Monday)** and will be posted on the Glass Door at our school entrance and uploaded to our website [www.mps.edu.hk](http://www.mps.edu.hk). Parents will be notified via ePOA from 10:00 a.m. on that day as well.

**3. Meeting with Parents/Applicants and Applicant's Portfolio**

According to guidelines stated in the EDB Leaflet---**Primary One Admission for September 2025**, “Schools must not conduct tests or interviews on the applicant children's acquired curriculum knowledge.” in the Discretionary Places Admission Stage. Our school, therefore, will **NOT** meet with parents/applicants and will **NOT** accept any form of portfolio.

Irrespective of whether the application is submitted via ePOA or in paper form, if more than one application is submitted, the applications for discretionary place will be rendered void.

If "Status of permanent resident of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region" in the last column of the Birth Certificate is "not established" or non-holder of Hong Kong Birth Certificate, the original and photocopy of travel document (s) (e.g. passport, overseas birth certificate) needs to be provided
3. HKID card/Passport/other proofs of identity of Applicant's parent/guardian (original & photocopy)  
If parent/guardian authorizes another party to submit the completed application form, the authorized person should provide the photocopy of the parent's/guardian's proof of identity

4. Proof of residential address in either parent's name (within the last three months) (original & photocopy)  
e.g. stamped tenancy agreement, demand note for rates, public housing tenancy agreement or water/electricity/town gas/residential telephone bills. Do not accept any bank letters, credit card statements, or tax bills

-- Sister's Hong Kong Birth Certificate (original & photocopy) 姊姊出生證明文件 (正本及副本)
7. Having a parent who is MPS graduate: 家長在本校畢業:  
-- Parent's Certificate of Graduation (original & photocopy) 家長畢業證書 (正本及副本)
8. Catholic Student: 天主教徒:  
-- Certificate of Baptism (original & photocopy) 領洗紙 (正本及副本)
